1. **Anna Elisabeth Webers** was born in 1820 in Hanover.^{1,2} (The marriage record says she was 34 years old.) She immigrated on 22 Nov 1854 to Arrival at New Orleans aboard the Ibers from port of Bremen, Germany.³ She died on 31 Dec 1906 at the age of 86 in St Louis County, Missouri.⁴ (Image 327) Anna was buried on 2 Jan 1907 in Sacred Heart Cemetery, Florissant, Missouri.⁵ (Image 327) Link to parents: Marriage record names parents Joannes Weder and Elisabethae Lipker.

NOTES

There is a passenger list from the ship Ibers, which landed at New Orleans Nov 22, 1854. Elisabeth Webers is with William Spies. The record says she is 38 years old. The handwriting is very clear.

Elisabeth married William Spies, 26 December 1854 in St. Mary of Victories Church, St. Louis, Missouri. (Film 007856491 on FamilySearch, Image 738) (The handwriting is poor on the marriage record. It is difficult to read her maiden name.)

The baptism record for Anna Maria Elisabeth (Mary) Spies said that the mother's name was Webery.

The death record from Sacred Heart Church, Florissant, says that Elizabeth was 89 years old when she died, but the 1870 census says she was much younger.
