1. **Antoine Overy**^{1,2,3,4} was born before 15 Jul 1838 in Florissant, St Louis County, Missouri.^{5,6} He was baptized on 15 Jul 1838 in St Ferdinand Catholic Church, Florissant, Missouri.⁷ (Images 31 and 247) He served in the military 85th Regiment Enrolled Missouri Militia (Union) (Enrolled at Florissant, Missouri) on 26 Sep 1862.⁸ Antoine died before 4 Jul 1899 at the age of 60 in St Louis, Missouri.⁹ He was buried on 4 Jul 1899 in St Ferdinand Cemetery, Florissant, Missouri, N.E. Sect 5 Lot 4.¹⁰ He was a Carpenter.¹¹ Link to parents: Baptism record names parents Louis Ouvre and Theresa Lorain. Godfather is Antoine Lorrain, brother of his mother. Godmother is Constance Ouvre, sister of his father.

Possibly made a claim for Military Pension for service in the Civil War. On September 30, 1891, Antoine Overy made a claim that he was in Co B 85th Missouri Milita from 1864 - 1865 as a Private. He was rejected on November 24, 1891. The claimant stood 5' 9" tall, had dark complexion, brown hair, and blue eyes. He suffered from Asthma, loss of hearing, and liver disease. The residence of the claimant was 3535 Salena Street, St Louis, Missouri. His wife was Cecily.
