1. Jacob Dvorak^{1,2,3} was born in 1816 in Bohemia.^{4,5,6} He was naturalized on 16 Oct 1876 in St Louis Court C.C.C.C.⁷ (Image 3635 Witness was his son-in-law, William Pollak.) He was buried in 1884 in New Picker Cemetery, St Louis, Missouri.⁸ In 1884 Jacob was a Stone Mason.^{9,10} (Image 438) He lived in 2021 Rosatti St, St Louis, Missouri in 1884.¹¹ He died on 22 Apr 1884 at the age of 68 in 2021 Rosatti Street, St Louis, Missouri.^{12,13}

NOTES

The 1860 census shows the family name Wureak. The census taker probably did not speak Czech. City of St Louis, Ward 1, page 297.

In the 1870 census, Jacob and Mary appear at the bottom of one page and their children (Frank, Theresa, John, and William) appear at the top of the next page.

In the 1880 census, it says that Jacob's sons John and William work in a saddle shop. William's death certificate says he was a saddler.
