1. **Maria Votava**<sup>1</sup> was born in Dec 1833 in Bohemia.<sup>2,3</sup> She immigrated in Mar 1872 to Baltimore from Bremen aboard SS Berlin.<sup>4</sup> She died before 27 Oct 1924 at the age of 90 in East St Louis, St Clair County, Illinois.<sup>5</sup> Maria was buried on 27 Oct 1924 in Mount Carmel Cemetery, Belleville, St Clair County, Illinois.<sup>6</sup> Link to parents: Death record names her father, Frank Votora.<sup>7</sup>
