The baptism record from St Thomas of Aquin church, which is in latin, says his name was "Gulielmus Athanasius." The application for social security says his name was "William Orville Spies."

On 14 September 1921, he married Augusta Dvorak (Film 007513862, Image 158) (St Louis marriage license # 252550, vol 98, page 303)

William Spies had tuberculosis, and went to a Veteran's Hospital in Danville, Illinois, in December of 1942. He died there in November, 1943. His son, William, used to talk about seeing his father off when he took the train to Danville at Christmas time.
