Alexander Stratton^{1,2} was born on 2 Jan 1822 in Oxford Township, Delaware County, Ohio.^{3,4,5,6} On 23 Aug 1850 he was a Farmer in Marlborough Township, Delaware County, Ohio.^{7,8} He served in the military At age 42, enlisted as a Private in the 145th Infantry Regiment (Ohio). on 12 May 1864.⁹ Alexander served in the military 145th fought Jubal Early when he attacked Washington on 11 Jul 1864.
